

## **Final examination assessment**

### **Rationale**

The final examination is designed to cover all learning objectives and to test both depth and breadth of students' knowledge relevant to the course.

### **Assessment details**

The final examination consists of a series of short-answer problems on a wide range of topics covered in the course with reference to lectures, identified texts, tutorials and assignments. The examination paper is worth a total of 50 marks.

### **Delivery**

A two hour final examination will be held during the final examination period. The examination paper is centrally organised. The examination is individual, closed-book and will contain multiple-choice, short-answer and short-essay questions. You may bring a battery-operated non-programmable calculator. Programmable calculators and other computing or communication devices are NOT permitted.
