

## **Tutorial assessment**

### **Rationale**

There are 12 tutorials scheduled in the course. Each tutorial has a theme which corresponds to the material discussed in the most recent lectures. The tutorials are primarily designed to allow the student to discuss issues relevant to the course with peers, and to solve practical problems relevant to the course.

### **Assessment details**

Each tutorial consists of a set of problems. The tutorial is available as a form. Each group provides written answers to all of the problems by filling in the form. The written answers need to be submitted as directed. The group may also be required to orally explain their answers to the tutorial class.

Each tutorial is assessed on basis of active attendance and contents of submission, and is worth 1 mark (with a maximum of 10 marks for the whole course).

### **Delivery**

Tutorials are completed in groups of no more than 4 students. A tutorial submission is regarded as collaborative work of the whole tutorial group. The tutorial will be made available in the week before it is scheduled. The answers need to be submitted within 72 hours after the scheduled tutorial session.

Answers and other relevant feedback on a tutorial will be discussed in class at the next available session.
